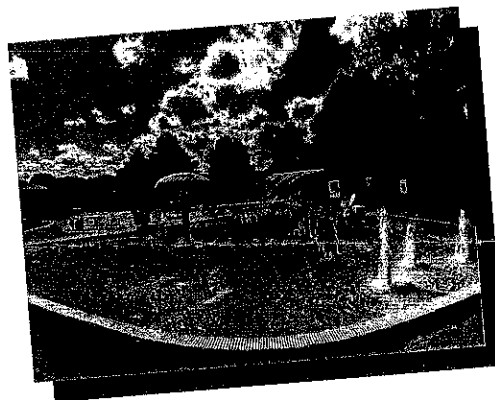

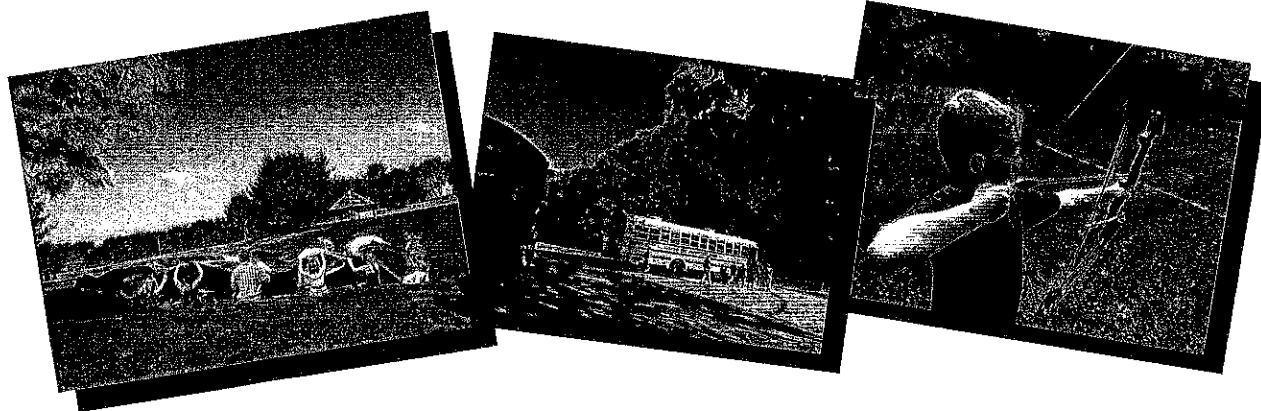

Camp is a fantastic opportunity for your child to experience out-of-doors living with their peers in a safe and friendly environment. Camp is 100% free, but spaces are limited. Please read this information to decide if a camp experience is right for your child.

ABOUT CAMP TANAGER

Camp Tanager was established in 1926 and has been offering free and reduced camperships for over half a century. Today, Camp Tanager serves over 600 campers each summer. Children are referred to camp by their school counselors. This free camp permits all children, regardless of income, the chance to enjoy a wonderful experience that combines fun and learning.

WHAT IS CAMP ALL ABOUT?

Camp is a warm, nurturing place where a child comes to learn, builds lasting friendships, create wonderful memories, and has tons of fun! Camp is about growing, building social skills, enhancing self-esteem and becoming a better person. Camp Tanager provides a safe, positive and friendly environment, empowering our campers, and helping them learn life skills such as the values of sharing, integrity, responsibility, and respect. We believe every camper should have the same opportunity for an incredible, safe, and fun filled summer camp experience.

ACTIVITIES AT CAMP

Campers may participate in a wide variety of traditional camping activities including; swimming, singing camp songs, sports and games, educational speakers, hiking, physical activities, arts & crafts, archery and nature studies. Campers will have the opportunity to make new friends and enjoy outdoor fun, while developing their physical and social skills. Camp is above all, a fun, loving, safe place to be. Many hours are spent laughing, playing games and doing all the things children love to do.

CAMP TANAGER STAFF

The success of our camp is due to the vital role our staff plays in your child's camp experience. Each summer we go to great lengths to find the most dedicated and experienced counselors. HOW TO APPLY

To meet eligibility guidelines campers should be between the ages of 6 -11. Camp Tanager is not a treatment facility, therefore Camp Tanager is not suitable for campers with severe behavioral disorders or physical disabilities.
